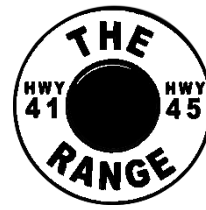

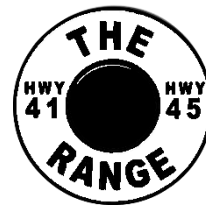

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

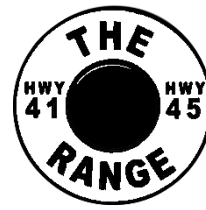
(READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING)

1. Members must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and be legally able to possess firearms. Applicants who have been convicted of a felony or other offense that prohibits the applicant from owning, using, or possessing a firearm or who have been ordered by a court not to possess a firearm will not be admitted as members and/or will have their memberships revoked without notice or refund. All members must execute TROR's form of Waiver, Release, and Indemnity Agreement in favor of TROR concurrent with the applicant's submission of the membership application and at such other times as TROR may request in its sole discretion.
2. Payment of all membership dues and fees shall be made on such date(s) and upon such terms and conditions as TROR may require. TROR reserves the right to assess reasonable charges and fees on all late payments. Failure to pay all dues, fees, and charges to TROR when due may result in the suspension, revocation, and/or termination of a members membership, without notice or refund, in TROR's sole discretion.
3. While at TROR's facility, all members and guests must at all times comply with all: (i) federal, state, and local laws concerning the ownership, handling, transportation, and/or use of firearms; and (ii) policies and rules established by TROR from time to time which are posted in the TROR facility and/or on TROR's web site (collectively, "TROR Policies and Rules"). Each member is responsible for ensuring that all guests who accompany the member to TROR's facility abide by the TROR Policies and Rules, and each member assumes full responsibility for his or her guests.
4. Members agree that, prior to participating in any shooting or other firearm related activities, they will inspect the surrounding area and the firearm and ammunition to be used and, if they believe anything is unsafe for any reason, they will immediately advise a TROR representative and cease any potentially unsafe activities.
5. TROR reserves the right from time to time in its sole discretion to change, limit, modify, or cancel, in whole or part (i) the benefits included within a membership category; (ii) these Terms and Conditions of Membership; and (iii) the TROR Policies and Rules. All such changes will be effective upon the posting of such changes in TROR's facility and on TROR's website.
6. TROR Membership is not transferable, does not constitute an ownership interest in TROR, and does not provide a right to participate in the management of TROR. TROR has the right at any time and without notice or refund to revoke a membership or the membership of any of members family members in the event a member, a members family member(s), or any of their guests, violate any of the TROR Policies and Rules, or become ineligible to be a member of TROR as a result of the conviction of a felony or otherwise.
7. Members shall be obligated to reimburse TROR for any damage to TROR property caused by a member and/or a members guest(s), whether accidental, negligent, intentional, or otherwise, and may suspend or revoke without notice or refund such member's membership privileges at TROR or remove any person who causes such damage.
8. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the internal laws of the State of Wisconsin. Any claim or legal proceedings arising out of membership in, or any occurrence while a member is present at, TROR, including the presence of any guests at TROR, and/or the interpretation of this Agreement, shall be venued in the Washington County Circuit Court for the State of Wisconsin.

WAIVER, RELEASE, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

(READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING)

- Inherent Risks:** I acknowledge that handling and shooting of firearms and archery equipment involve inherent dangers, hazards, and risks that cannot be completely eliminated. These dangers, hazards, and risks include personal injury to myself and others (including, but not limited to, ear damage, eye damage, other bodily injury, disability, and death) and damage to personal property resulting from the handling and shooting of firearms and archery equipment. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, I AM ASSUMING AND ACCEPTING ANY AND ALL INHERENT DANGERS, HAZARDS, AND RISKS OF PERSONAL INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE THAT MAY BE ASSOCIATED WITH THE HANDLING AND SHOOTING OF FIREARMS AND ARCHERY EQUIPMENT AT THE RANGE OF RICHFIELD, LLC ("TROR") BY ME, ANY TROR EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES, OR OTHERS AT TROR.
- Waiver and Release of Negligence Claims:** I fully, forever, knowingly, voluntarily, and irrevocably waive, release, and discharge TROR, and each of its owners, directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "TROR Parties"), from and against any and all claims, obligations, demands, damages, causes of action, liabilities, losses, and expenses of any nature whatsoever (including bodily injury or death to me or any of my guests, any damage to or destruction of any of my personal property or the property of my guests, reasonable attorneys' fees, expert fees, and court costs) (collectively, "Claims" or "Damages") against any TROR Party on account of or in any way related to or arising out of the following activities at TROR: (i) negligent handling of firearms and archery equipment; (ii) negligent firearm and archery shooting activities; and (iii) negligent supervision of TROR employees or representatives, members, and guests at TRORs facility.
- Indemnification:** I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the TROR Parties from and against any and all Claims and Damages suffered or incurred by any TROR Party as a result of, arising out of, or caused by any of my acts or omissions occurring at TROR's facility.
- Severability:** If any term or provision of this Agreement, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall to any extent be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected hereby, and each provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the extent permitted by law.
- Governing Law:** This Agreement shall be governed by the internal laws of the State of Wisconsin. Any claim or lawsuit arising out of my membership in, or any occurrence while I am present at, TROR, including the presence of any of my family member(s) or guests at TROR, and/or the interpretation of this Agreement, shall be venued in the Washington County Circuit Court for the State of Wisconsin.
- Understanding of Agreement: Opportunity to Negotiate:** I have read and fully understand this Agreement and its contents. Before signing this Agreement I have had the opportunity to consult with legal counsel concerning the significance and implications (legal and otherwise) of this document, and have been given the opportunity to negotiate with TROR regarding its terms, conditions, and covenants.
